• DMT senior women and senior men

Born 2007 or earlier

DMT junior girls and junior boys

Born 2008 to 2011

Un-official Nordic Trampoline competitions:

- U 14 girls and boys
- Junior boys and girls synchro (born 2008-2011)
- Senior women and men synchro (born 2007 or earlier or a senior and junior together)

Requirements

U14 girls and boys 6 summersaults of min. 270°

Junior girls and boys FIG B Senior women and men FIG A

Licenses

If the event will be FIG approved, all seniors must have a FIG license. If the event is FIG approved, we will update you in this regard by e-mail.

Entry Fee

Entry fee is **DKK 200** per gymnast per class.

Judges

Judges with a FIG brevet

A Nordic country participating in any of the official Nordic Championship events senior and/or junior are obliged to send 3 judges holding a valid FIG brevet.

Total number of judges

Regardless of the above, all participating clubs are obliged to send judges as follows:

3 participants or more
 10 participants or more
 30 participants or more
 30 participants or more
 31 judge (national or FIG brevet)
 32 judges (national or FIG brevet)
 33 judges (national or FIG brevet)

The same judge can be assigned as both Trampoline and DMT









Please note that the organizer will not pay for travel costs, food or accommodation for the judges.

Judges' Panels

The Judges' panels will be announced no later than one week before the competition.

Information

Registration Deadlines

Definitive registration: July 20th

• Registration form will be sent in due time to all clubs/national federations.

Nominative registration: September 20th

- Late nominative entries will be accepted until October 1st Registration or payment being made too late, implies a penalty of **DKK 750** per started week the registration/payment hasn't been paid.
- Rooming list will be incorporated in the nominative registration form.

Insurance

Nor the organizing club neither the Danish Gymnastics Federation can be held responsible for any liabilities in case of accidents and the like. Therefore, all delegations and participants must make their own arrangements as to insurance.

Accommodation & meals

The organizer offers accommodation for all participants. Accommodation is possible from Thursday to Sunday and is offered in various prize categories (see below). Booking of accommodation and meals as well as payment should be cleared **September 20th at the latest.** Accommodation and meal forms will be sent to the participating clubs and federations after the definitive registration.









Hotel Accommodation

Hotel accommodation is offered at Milling Hotels (Ansgar, Windsor, and Mini19) https://millinghotels.dk/hoteller/.

Single, twin, triple and quad rooms are possible (triple and quad rooms are available in limited numbers).

All hotels are in walking distance of the tram - se transportation.

Costs per person per night including breakfast:

Costs per person per night including breakfast:

Single, DKK 900

Double/Twin, DKK 560

Low-cost Accommodation

Accommodation in classrooms at a nearby school and Clubhouse is available in limited numbers. Both the school and Clubhouse are situated 5 minutes walking distance from the competition venue.

Costs per person per night including breakfast are **DKK 300**.

Bring your own mattress, sleeping bag etc.

It is possible to rent a limited number of mattresses at the cost of **DKK 25** per person per night.

Meals

Lunch and dinner are served at the Clubhouse - 5 minutes walking distance from the competition venue.

Lunch can be ordered for Friday and Saturday at a price of **DKK 120** per day per person. Dinner can be ordered for Thursday and Friday at a price of **DKK 150** per day per person.

You will be able to buy drinks, coffee and snacks in the Cafeteria located at the competition venue.

Banquette/Farwell Dinner

Will be held on Saturday 19th October at Odense Stadium next to the competition venue. The price is **DKK 450** per person.









Transportation

Transportation to Odense

You can fly to Copenhagen or Billund Airport. From Copenhagen take the train directly from Copenhagen Airport to the city center of Odense. It takes 1,5 hours.

You can go by car. There is a Highway all the way from Copenhagen to Odense. It takes approx. 1,5 hours.

Transportation in Odense

All participating federations and clubs are responsible for their own transportation to and from the competition venue/hotels.

There is a tram running to/from the city centre to the competition venue. It departs approx. every 10 minutes. The travel time is approx. 10 minutes each way.

If you travel by car it is possible to park outside the competition venue.

Financial obligations - payment

The Danish Gymnastics Federation will send individual invoice to the clubs/national federation after the definitive registration. In the definitive registration each club/national federation must give the contact information for the person who will receive the invoice.

The invoice will cover accommodation, meals/banquet and entry fee.

Orientation Meeting

The orientation meeting will be held on Thursday 19th October at 20.00 at the competition venue.

Nordic Meeting
